

The West Bend Farmers' Market is open for your Essential Food Needs

These regulations will be in place going forward and will be changed if needed based on the Washington/Ozaukee Blueprint to reopening

What will the Downtown West Bend Association do?

- There will be more handwashing stations at the market
- There will be social distancing signs and no eating at the market signs
- As always, no pets will be allowed

What will vendors do?

- Face masks are highly encouraged
- No sampling
- Prepared food or drinks it must be to go ONLY. Everything must be pre-packaged to consume off site.
- No shopper contact with product. Only vendors will touch the product until sold. Example A shopper will point to a tomato and the vendor puts in a bag.
- Have a three foot barrier table between products and the customer
- No sick vendors or employees at the market.
- Packaged items are to be pre-weighted to limit food handling.
- Vendors will clean/sanitize/disinfect surfaces including tables and tablecloths before the market.
- Vendors will wash hands regularly with soap and water and use hand sanitizer only when necessary on clean hands.
- Vendors will use single use gloves where needed.

What can customers do?

- Practice social distancing
- We will highly encourage customers to wear facemasks
- We ask that customers do not touch any of the products until purchased. Please point to the item you wish to purchase, and the vendor will place it in a single use bag for you.
- Food and beverages along with pre-packaged items must be consumed off site.
- No sick customers are allowed at the market.
- Customers will need to minimize the number of people coming with them to the market to keep the crowds smaller.
- As always please leave your pets at home
